Biography

Edward Steinfeld is the Howard R. Swearer Director of the Thomas J. Watson Institute for International and Public Affairs, Dean's Professor of China Studies, professor in the Department of Political Science, and director of the China Initiative. Steinfeld received his BA, MA, and PhD in political science from Harvard University.

In addition to a variety of academic articles, Steinfeld is the author of *Playing Our Game: Why China's Rise Doesn't Threaten the West* (Oxford, 2010) and *Forging Reform in China: The Fate of State-Owned Industry* (Cambridge, 1998). He is the author of numerous articles in both academic and non-academic journals, including *Comparative Politics*, *Political Studies*, *World Development*, the *Far Eastern Economic Review*, the *Washington Post*, the *Wall Street Journal*, and the *South China Morning Post*.

Steinfeld is a member of the academic committee of the Center for Industrial Development and Environmental Governance at Tsinghua University, and has served as a consultant to the World Bank, the International Finance Corporation, and a variety of governmental agencies, NGOs, and multinational firms.
