Corkscrew Swamp Sanctuary is one of Audubon's gems – it is located off Immokalee Road 15 miles east of I-75. Turn left right after the big bend at the Corkscrew sign on state road 849 and then turn left onto Sanctuary Road West (374 Sanctuary Road).

Lunch is at the Heritage Bay Clubhouse where Carol and Stan Woolf are members – on the right on Immokalee as your return toward Naples; pay with credit card.

- Corkscrew Swamp Sanctuary only accepts advance on-line reservations, as they are limiting the number of people who can be on the Boardwalk at any given time. No walkins accepted.
